

# Tithes

## Old Testament:

**Genesis 14:20** And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.

**Leviticus 27:30** And all the tithes of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD's: it is holy unto the LORD.

**Leviticus 27:31** And if a man will at all redeem ought of his tithes, he shall add thereto the fifth part thereof.

**Leviticus 27:32** And concerning the tithes of the herd, or of the flock, even of whatsoever passeth under the rod, the tenth shall be holy unto the LORD.

**Numbers 18:24** But the tithes of the children of Israel, which they offer as an heave offering unto the LORD, I have given to the Levites to inherit: therefore I have said unto them, Among the children of Israel they shall have no inheritance.

**Numbers 18:26** Thus speak unto the Levites, and say unto them, When ye take of the children of Israel the tithes which I have given you from them for your inheritance, then ye shall offer up an heave offering of it for the LORD, even a tenth part of the tithes.

**Numbers 18:28** Thus ye also shall offer an heave offering unto the LORD of all your tithes, which ye receive of the children of Israel; and ye shall give thereof the LORD's heave offering to Aaron the priest.

**Deuteronomy 12:6** And thither ye shall bring your burnt offerings, and your sacrifices, and your tithes, and heave offerings of your hand, and your vows, and your freewill offerings, and the firstlings of your herds and of your flocks:

**Deuteronomy 12:11** Then there shall be a place which the LORD your God shall choose to cause his name to dwell there; thither shall ye bring all that I command you; your burnt offerings, and your sacrifices, your tithes, and the heave offering of your hand, and all your choice vows which ye vow unto the LORD:

**Deuteronomy 12:17** Thou mayest not eat within thy gates the tithes of thy corn, or of thy wine, or of thy oil, or the firstlings of thy herds or of thy flock, nor any of thy vows which thou vowest, nor thy freewill offerings, or heave offering of thine hand:

**Deuteronomy 14:22** Thou shalt truly tithe all the increase of thy seed, that the field bringeth forth year by year.

# Tithes

**Deuteronomy 14:23** And thou shalt eat before the LORD thy God, in the place which he shall choose to place his name there, the tithe of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the firstlings of thy herds and of thy flocks; that thou mayest learn to fear the LORD thy God always.

**Deuteronomy 14:28** At the end of three years thou shalt bring forth all the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay it up within thy gates:

**Deuteronomy 26:12** When thou hast made an end of tithing all the tithes of thine increase the third year, which is the year of tithing, and hast given it unto the Levite, the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, that they may eat within thy gates, and be filled;

**2Chronicles 31:5** And as soon as the commandment came abroad, the children of Israel brought in abundance the firstfruits of corn, wine, and oil, and honey, and of all the increase of the fields; and the tithe of all things brought they in abundantly.

**2Chronicles 31:6** And concerning the children of Israel and Judah, that dwelt in the cities of Judah, they also brought in the tithe of oxen and sheep, and the tithe of holy things which were consecrated unto the LORD their God, and laid them by heaps.

**2Chronicles 31:12** And brought in the offerings and the tithes and the dedicated things faithfully: over which Cononiah the Levite was ruler, and Shimei his brother was the next.

**Nehemiah 10:37** And that we should bring the firstfruits of our dough, and our offerings, and the fruit of all manner of trees, of wine and of oil, unto the priests, to the chambers of the house of our God; and the tithes of our ground unto the Levites, that the same Levites might have the tithes in all the cities of our tillage.

**Nehemiah 10:38** And the priest the son of Aaron shall be with the Levites, when the Levites take tithes: and the Levites shall bring up the tithe of the tithes unto the house of our God, to the chambers, into the treasure house.

**Nehemiah 12:44** And at that time were some appointed over the chambers for the treasures, for the offerings, for the firstfruits, and for the tithes, to gather into them out of the fields of the cities the portions of the law for the priests and Levites: for Judah rejoiced for the priests and for the Levites that waited.

# Tithes

**Nehemiah 13:5** And he had prepared for him a great chamber, where aforetime they laid the meat offerings, the frankincense, and the vessels, and the tithes of the corn, the new wine, and the oil, which was commanded to be given to the Levites, and the singers, and the porters; and the offerings of the priests.

**Nehemiah 13:12** Then brought all Judah the tithes of the corn and the new wine and the oil unto the treasuries.

**Amos 4:4** Come to Bethel, and transgress; at Gilgal multiply transgression; and bring your sacrifices every morning, and your tithes after three years:

**Malachi 3:8** Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

**Malachi 3:10** Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

## New Testament:

**Matthew 23:23** Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithes of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

**Luke 11:42** But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the love of God: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

**Luke 18:12** I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.

**Acts 2:44** And all that believed were together, and had all things common;

**Acts 4:32** And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

**1Corinthians 9:1** Am I not an apostle? am I not free? have I not seen Jesus Christ our Lord? are not ye my work in the Lord?

**1Corinthians 9:2** If I be not an apostle unto others, yet doubtless I am to you: for the seal of mine apostleship are ye in the Lord.

# Tithes

**1 Corinthians 9:3** Mine answer to them that do examine me is this,

**1 Corinthians 9:4** Have we not power to eat and to drink?

**1 Corinthians 9:5** Have we not power to lead about a sister, a wife, as well as other apostles, and as the brethren of the Lord, and Cephas?

**1 Corinthians 9:6** Or I only and Barnabas, have not we power to forbear working?

**1 Corinthians 9:7** Who goeth a warfare any time at his own charges? who planteth a vineyard, and eateth not of the fruit thereof? or who feedeth a flock, and eateth not of the milk of the flock?

**1 Corinthians 9:8** Say I these things as a man? or saith not the law the same also?

**1 Corinthians 9:9** For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth God take care for oxen?

**1 Corinthians 9:10** Or saith he it altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, this is written: that he that ploweth should plow in hope; and that he that thresheth in hope should be partaker of his hope.

**1 Corinthians 9:11** If we have sown unto you spiritual things, is it a great thing if we shall reap your carnal things?

**1 Corinthians 9:12** If others be partakers of this power over you, are not we rather? Nevertheless we have not used this power; but suffer all things, lest we should hinder the gospel of Christ.

**1 Corinthians 9:13** Do ye not know that they which minister about holy things live of the things of the temple? and they which wait at the altar are partakers with the altar?

**1 Corinthians 9:14** Even so hath the Lord ordained that they which preach the gospel should live of the gospel.

**2 Corinthians 11:7** Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely?

**2 Corinthians 11:8** I robbed other churches, taking wages of them, to do you service.

**2 Corinthians 11:9** And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all things I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and so will I keep myself.

# Tithes

**2 Corinthians 12:13** For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except it be that I myself was not burdensome to you? forgive me this wrong.

**2 Corinthians 12:14** Behold, the third time I am ready to come to you; and I will not be burdensome to you: for I seek not yours, but you: for the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children.

**Hebrews 7:1** For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him;

**Hebrews 7:2** To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace;

**Hebrews 7:3** Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually.

**Hebrews 7:4** Now consider how great this man was, unto whom even the patriarch Abraham gave the tenth of the spoils.

**Hebrews 7:5** And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the office of the priesthood, have a commandment to take tithes of the people according to the law, that is, of their brethren, though they come out of the loins of Abraham:

**Hebrews 7:6** But he whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises.

**Hebrews 7:7** And without all contradiction the less is blessed of the better.

**Hebrews 7:8** And here men that die receive tithes; but there he receiveth them, of whom it is witnessed that he liveth.

**Hebrews 7:9** And as I may so say, Levi also, who receiveth tithes, payed tithes in Abraham.

**Hebrews 7:10** For he was yet in the loins of his father, when Melchisedec met him.
